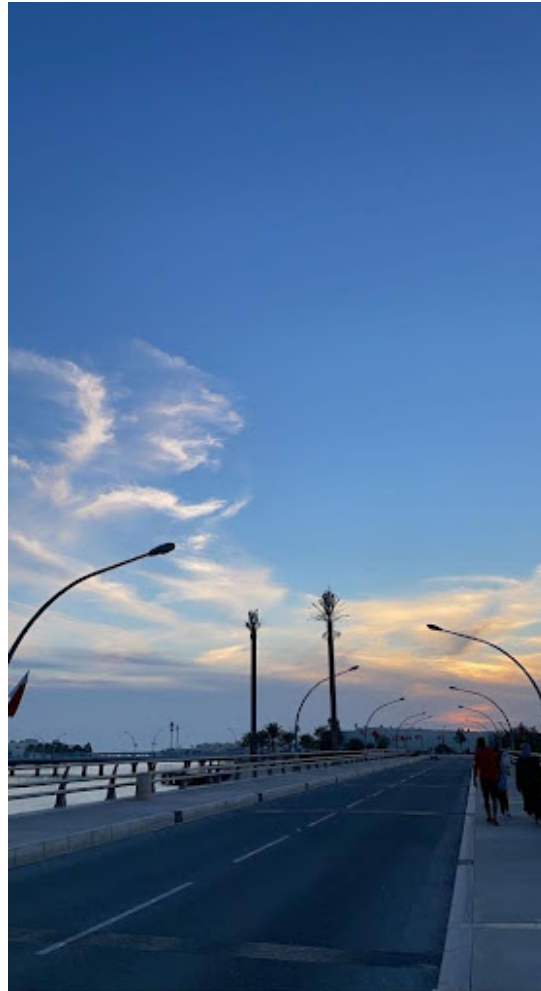
HAMAD MUBARAK AL KHALIFA

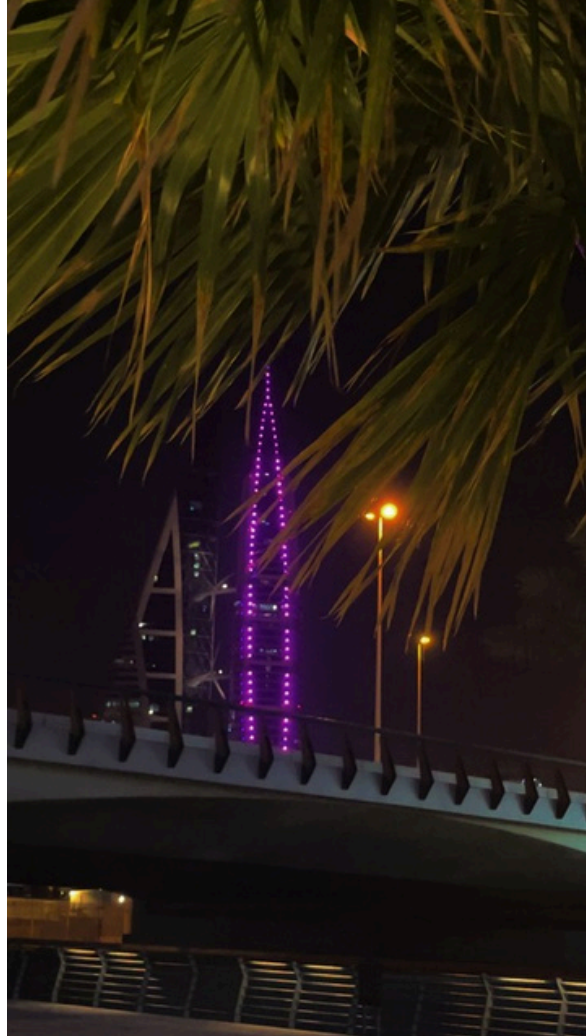
MAYAR BIN HUWAIL
