The Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities invites you to the opening of Bani Jamra Naseej Factory on Wednesday the 23rd of December starting at 3pm. Architecturally, this factory is influenced by its location as Leopard Banchini drew inspiration from the memory of the palm tree materials (Barasti) once used for construction. It provides a shaded space within to incubate weaving and spinning works, and the factory includes units for weaving using authentic traditional methods, as well as workshops teaching this craft and a shop for products.

From the book "Treasures of Bahrain" pictured above; one of the most important traditional pieces that is created with different stones and designs, called the "Alyem'aa" and it looks like an embossed box, which can be opened and Quranic prayers can be placed inside. The bigger "Alyem'aa" is worn by elder woman as for the smaller one, it's worn by younger children and it's called "Alyem'aa" or "Alherz" because it protects from the evil eye and envy.

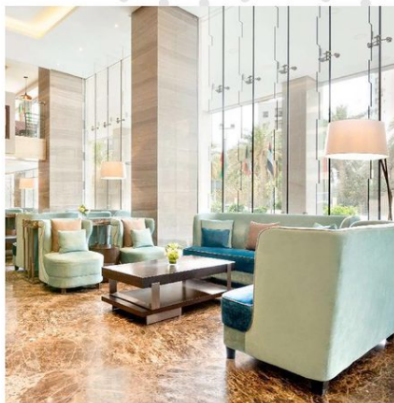

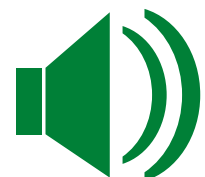
