HEADLINE High Ranking for Covid Relief



Bahrain tops GCC states and ranks among the world's top countries in supporting citizens and residents as well as private companies most affected by Covid-19 in proportion to the GDP, according to a report released by KPMG. The report covers the impact of the pandemic on GCC banking services and analysis of potential measures to confront it.

Bahrain provided a BD3.4 billion economic stimulus package, the equivalent of 30 per cent of its annual GDP, to support citizens and the private sector, the report said.

HEADLINE Covid-19 Vaccine may be ready by year-end



A vaccine against Covid-19 may be ready by year-end, the head of the World Health Organization said on Tuesday. WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus called for solidarity and political commitment by all leaders to ensure equal distribution of vaccines when they become available.

"We will need vaccines and there is hope that by the end of this year we may have a vaccine. There is hope," Tedros said in final remarks to the WHO's Executive Board, without elaborating.

Nine experimental vaccines are in the pipeline of the WHO's COVAX global vaccine facility that aims to distribute 2 billion doses by the end of 2021.


