

Update: Pfizer Boosters to Recipients of Chinese Vaccine

Due to battling a sharp resurgence of Covid-19 despite high levels of inoculation with a Chinese-made vaccine, booster shots have been made available to vulnerable citizens using a different vaccine. Bahrain residents who are over 50, are obese or have chronic illnesses now are being urged to get another shot six months after their full Sinopharm vaccination—with the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. The government's BeAware app allows users to book a Sinopharm booster shot, but says that Pfizer-BioNTech is recommended for more-vulnerable population groups.

Sputnik V factory to be built in Bahrain for Middle East, North Africa consumers

A factory will be built in Bahrain to manufacture Russia's Sputnik V coronavirus vaccine for consumers in the Middle East and North Africa, the Russian Direct Investment Fund (RDIF) said in a statement on Thursday. The agreement was signed on the sidelines of the St. Petersburg International Economic Forum. Bahrain authorized the emergency use of the Russian vaccine in February 2021.

Bahrain took pole position in Group C of the Asian Qualifiers for the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 and AFC Asian Cup China 2023, after beating Cambodia 8-0 on Thursday.

The victory took Bahrain to 12 points, one ahead of Iraq who have a match in hand with Islamic Republic of Iran up next for Helio Sousa's side on Monday. Iran defeated Hong Kong 3-1 in their match to move nine points.

This Local Firefighter Rescued a Family of Six From a House Fire

Mohammed Salem, a 33 year old off-duty firefighter from Hamad Town saved a family of six from a blaze that completely destroyed the ground floor of their building and trapped them upstairs. As he was washing his car outside his home, he saw smoke arising from a building in his neighbourhood and heard screams for help. Hailed as a hero, this man suffered from several bruises, a broken nose, and smoke inhalation after scaling across rooftops to save the family. He has since been honoured by the Ministry of Interior as well as by the Gulf Petrochemical Industries Company President, Dr. Abdelrahman Jawhari.

Tate Museum just announced this photo of the Bahrain International Circuit as it's Work of the Week!
