HH Sheikh Nassers Fast Attack Filly Wins in the UK Godolphin Horse Race

Sheikh Nasser's mare Fast Attack is the winner of the Godolphin Lifetime Care Oh So Sharp Stakes Group 3 race at the Newmarket racecourse in the United Kingdom. The distance covered by the race was 1,400 meters. It briefly appeared that Fast Attack, when entering the dip during the Rowley Mile, could be swallowed by Doyle. In the end, Fast Attack (9-1) triumphed, pulling a length clear while Allayaali laid down the gauntlet. His Majesty King Hamad's representative for humanitarian work and youth affairs Shaikh Nasser bin Hamad Al Khalifa praised the victory. He added that it will be a source of motivation for future races. Bahrain's equestrian achievements overseas confirm Bahrain's distinguished international position, he said. In an effort to continue the victory march, he underlined that he is eager to support the Kingdom's participation on the international stage. Shaikh Nasser considers the race to be one of the top international races. He lauds Fawzi Nass and trainer Crisford, as well as jockey Doyle.

Bahrain Ranks Second for COVID-19 Recovery in the World

Bahrain has been ranked second in the Nikkei Covid-19 Recovery Index among 120 countries. This is for the time period until September 30th. Bahrain ranks higher than Malta, while Chile shares second place with Bahrain. The index assesses 121 countries and regions in terms of COVID recovery by calculating a score between 0 and 90 based on nine factors divided into three categories: infection management, vaccine rollouts, and mobility. As a country rises in the rankings, it is closer to recovering — with low infection rates, higher immunization rates, and fewer restrictions on social interactions. Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates both scored 71%, and Bahrain scored 72%, just one point behind Malta. The methodology for the ranking has updated to reflect vaccination progress worldwide, according to Nikkei. In addition to assessing the proportion of people who received at least one shot, there is also a subcategory for vaccinations that looks at the percentage of people who are fully vaccinated with 2 shots.

Bahraini Bikers Go Pink in Support of Pinktober

To spread awareness about early detection of cancer, Rotaract Bahrain has joined forces with Think Pink Bahrain, Lulu Hypermarket, and the Bahrain International Circuit for the bike parade for cancer awareness.



Apparently, Last Month Was the 2nd Sunniest September in Bahrain Since 1968

According to a report by the Meteorological Directorate, last month was the 2nd sunniest September in Bahrain since sunshine records began in 1968, and we totally felt that. The highest temperature recorded during the month of September was 46C at Bahrain International Circuit on the 3rd of September. The second and third highest temperatures recorded were 44.1C at Durrat Al Bahrain on September 6th and 42.3C at Bahrain International Airport on September 4th. The average temperature of the month was 33.9C, 0.7C higher than usual. The first sunniest September since 1968 was September of 2014 with the average temperature for the month being 33.9C, 1.5C higher than usual. Temperatures have been soaring all around the world and fingers are being pointed at Global Warming for the reason why. Let's all hope for better climate conditions.

Beach Padel


