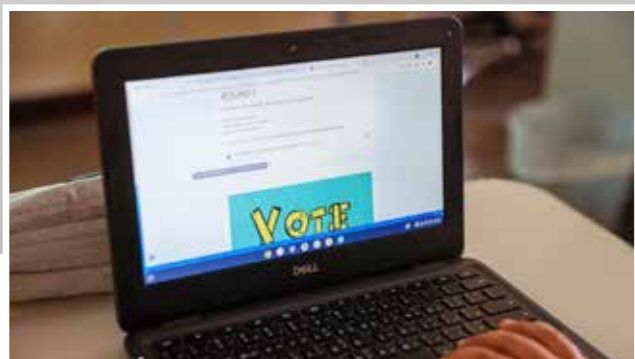

TIER Has Launched E-Scooter Service in Bahrain!

TIER, the Berlin-based company has launched in Bahrain and we're super stoked. TIER is a micro-mobility company backed by SoftBank, with e-scooter services across 135 cities in 14 countries, in Middle East and Europe. TIER was founded in 2018 and has been expanding ever since, and we can't wait to try the service out in the Kingdom! So how it works? Riders can download the app, select an e-scooter or an e-bike on the virtual map and unlock it by scanning the presented QR code. To end the ride, you can use TIER's virtual parking system, where you'll simply need to locate a designated safe parking spot and click on the 'End Ride' button. only 0.1 BD per minute and 0.3 BD to unlock one. The first time users are also getting a promo discount, just use the promo code 'TIERBAH' and get 2 free unlocks and 30 minutes of free ride! How cool is that! They even have easy packages for frequent users.
