

E-government": providing the reservation for the Corona test service by "cars" through the application of "conscious society"



The Information and eGovernment Authority announced the provision of appointment reservation service to conduct the final examination of cases subject to home quarantine through vehicles through the "conscious community" application, in keeping with the new examination mechanism announced by the Ministry of Health and presented at the examination center at the Bahrain International Exhibition and Convention Center dedicated to examining cases, what It reflects the government's keenness to provide more facilities for citizens and residents to carry out tests within the precautionary and preventive plans aimed at limiting the spread of the Corona virus.

The centre will be operating all week from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm and the examination is conducted with an average time of up to 5 minutes across 8 stations.

Commercial and industrial businesses reopened last night


