

His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa, the Crown Prince, Deputy Supreme Commander and First Deputy Prime Minister, today chaired a meeting of the Government Executive Committee, held remotely. During the meeting, the Crown Prince reaffirmed that Bahrain has mobilised the full strength of its resources in order to safeguard public health and overcome obstacles imposed by the global spread of Covid-19, under the leadership of HM King Hamad.





Plasma clinical project completed on 40 patients and results are being analysed by experts, said National Taskforce for Combating Coronavirus (Covid-19) monitoring committee head Lt Col Dr Manaf Al Qahtani.

The capacities of Covid-19 facilities have been increased to provide efficient treatment as part of the national efforts, an official said today. Isolation and treatment facilities have 7,187 beds of which 4,884 are occupied, said Health Ministry Under-Secretary Dr Waleed Al Manea. In quarantine, there are 3,410 beds of which 599 are occupied. Treatment is free in public facilities, while optional paid services are available in the private sector.





Wearing face masks are mandatory in public places, and while visiting the elderly and those with high immunity risk, said Health Ministry Under-Secretary Dr Waleed Al Manea. "The only exceptions are while exercising or inside vehicles.




More than 300,000 Covid-19 tests have been conducted in Bahrain so far and the increased capacity of facilities has led to the good recovery rate in the region, said National Taskforce for Combating Coronavirus (Covid-19) monitoring committee member and SMC Infectious and Internal Diseases consultant Dr Jameela Al Salman. "The aim is to achieve higher recoveries," she added. She reiterated the need to follow the basic guidelines, including social distancing, and called upon people to "be responsible".





Recklessness and non-compliance with health's safety guidelines and precautionary measures has once again led to a surge in coronavirus (Covid-19) cases in Bahrain, a top official has said. Health Ministry Under-Secretary Dr Waleed Al Manea pointed out that the recent spread of infection has been mainly among Bahrainis as a result of family and social gatherings during Ramadan and Eid Al Fitr. The number of cases among citizens had gone from 16 on April 16 to 179 on Tuesday, he said.


