## World Robotics Olympiad Invitational Tournament (WROFIT)

For the first time at Bahrain Bayan School, the middle and high school WRO teams took part in the summer WRO Friendship Tournament in Denmark. WRO Friendship Invitational offers all age groups in both Open and Regular to work with the 2019 challenges “Smart cities”. Around 140 teams attended the Friendship Invitational Tournament from around the world who participated in the competition. The elementary team made it at number 14 amongst the other teams. Bayan teams worked tirelessly and showed their quality which has impressed everyone in the tournament, in the second day of the competition the organizers changed the challenge completely to test the team’s abilities, Bayan teams did really well at that. I am personally proud of each member in the Bayan teams for their work ethics, sportsmanship and dedication.
