

Safety Measures

#	Question	Answer	
1	What are the school's rules if we come back from outside of Bahrain by the end of August?	Students traveling must quarantine for 10 days before attending school for on-campus learning. Parents must notify the school of their travel plans and return date by filling a form to confirm when their children may attend on-campus. The BBS Administration will send the form via SMS during the week of August 15th.	
2	Will there be any healthcare staff on campus?	Yes, the school has 3 infirmaries, 2 on the main campus and one on the Preschool campus. Health care staff include 1 doctor and 2 nurses on the main campus and 1 nurse in the preschool building.	
3	Will students be required to wear masks?	Yes. As per the National Task Force and MoE regulations, students must be wearing masks except when eating. BBS will update the regulations according to the National Task Force updates.	
4	Will there be social distancing in the classrooms?	As per the national regulations, desks will be spaced 1 meter apart.	
5	Will there be rapid testing for students?	BBS will follow the National Task Force, Ministry of Health, and Ministry of Education's recommendation for administering rapid tests. Parents will be notified of the updated regulations before school starts.	
6	Are students aged 12 and above required to be vaccinated to attend school?	Students do not have to be vaccinated to be on- campus. Still, BBS highly recommends parents vaccinate their eligible children (12 years old and above) for their own safety and the safety of the community. Unvaccinated students aged 12 years and above will undergo Covid-19 Rapid Tests more frequently. The BBS Administration will share more information regarding on-campus testing soon.	
7	Will there be a temperature check for students?	Yes, the school will still follow the safety measure of checking students' temperatures at the door before they enter the classroom.	

8	Can parents, nannies, or drivers come on campus during pick-up and drop- off?	No, parents, nannies, and drivers are to remain in their cars during drop-off and pick-up procedures to maintain safety measures. The school will be sending a detailed presentation to parents regarding drop-off and pick-up procedures soon.	
9	Can students bring in food with them?	Students are allowed to bring in lunch boxes with them. However, sharing food is not allowed.
